Oktoberfest Celebration at Graze in Peace

Fundraiser for Farm Animal Rescue and Learning Center

DURHAM, MAINE - Graze in Peace Farm Animal Rescue and Learning Center will be holding an Oktoberfest Celebration fundraiser from 3pm - 7pm, Saturday, October 7th at the Graze in Peace farm in Durham, Maine. Live music will be provided by Pejepscot Station, a high-energy bluegrass band from mid-coast Maine. Germanthemed plant-based foods will be catered by Fuego Diablo of Pownal and will include vegan beer brats, hot dogs, salads, sides, local apple cider, beer and wine. Pretzels by Hootenanny Bakery of Damariscotta will also be available for purchase along with a variety of baked goods.

Graze in Peace is a 501(c)(3) non-profit farm animal rescue located on 20 acres twenty-five miles north of Portland, Maine. Co-founders, Carl and Deborah Schwink, operated the rescue privately for ten years prior to turning it into a non-profit organization. By opening the doors to their farm they hope to engage more people from the local community to help them do more for at-risk animals and people in the southern Maine area.

The fundraiser will include a pre-party event for sponsors followed by dinner, farm tours, family friendly games and a silent auction. Proceeds from the event will be used to care for and feed the rescued animals who are lifelong residents at the farm. Funds will also be used to jumpstart the "care farm" program at Graze where vulnerable people in the local community, including disabled and at-risk youth and adults, will have access to a community center for therapeutic and educational activities, as well as fully accessible raised garden beds and a nature trail where visitors can observe the animal residents in their natural setting.
